



Aquabait Pty Ltd is providing quality Marine worms for fishing bait from its aquaculture farm which is situated on Lake Macquarie catchment, Central Coast of New South Wales, Australia.

Since 1996, Aquabait has been scientifically researching and developing its unique technology for cultivating marine worms.



Aquabait has applied a method of farming marine worms in a sustainable manner, in turn being an environmentally aware company.

Currently the marine worm being cultivated is a close relative to the beach worm, known as the tube-worm. The tube-worm is grown up to 30cm/ 1ft in length on Aquabait Marine Worm farm.

Aquabait Pty Ltd provides live worms and preserved worms. The live worms are sold to bait retailers from the farm, and the preserved worms are sold to wholesalers in different regions around Australia. Aquabait Pty Ltd does not sell direct to the public.

Aquabait's preserved worms can last several months in the freezer, and have a firmer texture for easier hook threading!

Aquabait's marine worms will catch a large variety of estuarine, benthic, reef and pelagic fish. Most fish rely upon marine worms from an early stage in their lives so are familiar with the worms scent already. A few examples of fish known to be caught on our worms are: bream, flathead, whiting, mulloway, dart, morwong, blackfish, squire, flounder and leather jacket just to name a few!
